



Travel Frequently Asked Questions

- What is travel soccer?
 - Travel soccer is a program designed for the more serious athlete and family ready to make a commitment to the sport, both financially and in time. The travel season technically takes place in the Spring (April through June). However, given the dedication to the sport in Brockton, teams are established in the Summer. This will give us plenty of time to create the teams and give the teams an opportunity to play together over the winter. Travel teams will practice in local gymnasiums over the winter starting in early January.
 - Some BYSA travel teams may participate in the South Shore Soccer League (SSSL) Fall travel program.
 - Brockton Youth Soccer does not sanction indoor games and has no affiliation with any of the local facilities. As such we have no control over scheduling or team placement.
- Travel soccer is sanctioned by Brockton Youth Soccer and South Shore Soccer League. SSSL is a part of Mass Youth Soccer and consists of member towns from our immediate area.
- Travel teams range from U10 thru U19.
- All U10 games are non-results oriented. While scores are kept, no standings are enforced as all divisions are geared towards player development, not wins or losses.
- Brockton Youth Soccer conducts an evaluation process for all players interested in playing travel soccer. Each year, players participate in one or more evaluation sessions, where they are measured in three key areas of the game, tactical, technical and physical. Evaluations include Brockton Youth Soccer Board Members, coaches for that division and other knowledgeable soccer participants.
- What are the Registration fees for Travel?

Please Note: Fees below does not include Domes or Tournaments. Those are additional fees.

 - Travel Early Registration
 - \$60 each - Discount of \$20 for 3rd, \$35 for 4th+ child
 - Travel Late Registration
 - \$70 each - Discount of \$20 for 3rd, \$35 for 4th+ child
- ***NOTE: Discount price only applies when entire family is registered together.**
 - Travel Uniform Fee - \$45 each
 - Travel Gym Fee for winter - \$15
- What happens if I do not make the travel team after tryouts?
 - If you do not make a travel team, you have the option to play our In-house Intramural program.
- Who are the coaches of our Travel Program?
 - All coaches are volunteer parents from BYSA who have passed a CORI check. Coaches are encouraged to participate in Mass Youth Soccer's coach education licensing program and BYSA would reimburse the fee associated with the course.
